Pastor Clay Ward:

The Romans 1-8 conference in Hermon, Maine was an encouraging and exciting time soaking in the book of Romans. Many people expressed their appreciation for the clear Gospel teaching and the clarification regarding the grace means of living the spiritual life.

The teaching team in Maine, consisting of myself, John Wry, Carlos Tellez, David Roseland, Mike Reagal, Ryan Robinson, Mark Rabon, and Alan Snow, was strong. I enjoyed learning as well as participating. Having been a part of many DM2 workshops, I have heard many encouraging responses from those in attendance, but this time I was hit with another benefit of being involved in a workshop – one aspect of disciple making that goes unnoticed and perhaps unappreciated is what takes place behind the scenes. I was personally encouraged and strengthened by the fellowship and unity of the teaching team in Maine.

We began the workshop with prayer the night before, together with the pastor of the host church. I was blessed by the prayers offered before the throne of grace by my fellow disciple makers on behalf one another, our families, and that God’s message would be clearly communicated. At other times several of us, realizing some difficulties being faced, would pray for strength and clarity for each other. Carlos Tellez (Regional Ministry Director): In the month of October I had the opportunity, along with John Wry, Ryan Robinson, and Pastor Clay Ward, to teach a Romans 1-8 DM2 workshop in Bangor, Maine at Hermon Baptist Church. There was good attendance and we were well received by the pastor. It was exciting to teach Romans 1-8 shoulder-to-shoulder with other teachers who came to help us from Connecticut. The following testimonies after the workshop were so encouraging:

"I don't know what it is but... I guess I want to say that I am changed. I am not saying I got saved, I was saved, but this really radically encouraged my salvation."

"This conference was excellent and I can't wait for more. It was a clear, concise, Scripture-focused Bible study of Romans."

"Now I have a new appreciation of Jesus and of God and the elimination of the 'I' syndrome in salvation, i.e., I have to do this and I have to do that. Thank you so much."

"I grew up positively in my salvation, but this is the best thing that ever happened to me. I am telling you... I can take this into the military, I can take it to the youth... I am fired up!"

"I appreciate how you cleared up a bunch of theology that was taught to me from the beginning when I got saved."

John Wry (Regional Ministry Director): Pipe dreams are sometimes nothing more than an active imagination. Yet when you place a pipe dream in the hands of Almighty God and He answers with an overwhelming "yes" you cannot help but feel humbled at the awesomeness of our loving Father.

When I got together with Pastor Chute in Hermon, Maine and shared with him the idea of holding a Romans 1-8 workshop, his response was nothing short of affirmative. So, by faith, we pressed on, not having a clue how it would turn out. Pastor Chute began inviting people all over the area. Hundreds of invitations were sent out. Also radio announcements, church bulletins, flyers and emails were sent out. I began working on planning the dates and hoping against hope that maybe a couple of guys would be available to come up and help teach.

I sit here writing this to you, our dear team of prayer warriors, just after wrapping up the event (and before going to bed). In the end, there was a total of eight teachers teaching the gospel of Jesus Christ under the authority of the Scriptures. Pastor David Roseland came from Connecticut with four men, Ryan Robinson came from Texas, Carlos Tellez from North Carolina, and Pastor Clay Ward from Tennessee. What a variety. We are in our 30's, 40's, 50's and even 70's. Some work full time, others work part time so they can serve in ministry, and two are full time pastors. Ryan, Carlos and me are full time DM2'ers. What a wonderful thing as we listened to these eight different perspectives share one and the same Gospel message.

Over sixty people from several different churches were in attendance. The hours were from 9am to 9pm for three days, and the number of people attending only grew as the event progressed.

It's wonderful to see a hunger for God's Word in North America! The testimonies shared at the end confirmed the working of God through the message preached.

We hope to be able to go back and continue teaching in the not so distant future. Please be in prayer.

SE Asia

Brad Rigby (Regional Ministry Director): Encircled by mountains, this Asian city boasts of picturesque beauty; however, believers here are boasting in the grace of the Gospel of Christ. (Eph. 2:8-9) Now in our third training workshop at this location, DM2 continues to emphasize the true grace Gospel: that Christ died for your sins and rose again. (1 Cor. 15:3-4) With new attendees each trip, our team continues to emphasize the Gospel, the believer's eternal security in Christ, and the challenge to become disciple makers.

Nevertheless, the primary teaching for this workshop was Romans 9-16 wherein Paul emphasized Israel's past, present and future. Then he addressed the believer in the church regarding his responsibility to be a living sacrifice to God within his local assembly, to fellow believers, to his government, and to the world at large. Our team, Drew Smith and I, taught over 31 hours through this material. As expected, some attendees were confused about dispensations and the distinction between the church and Israel. Others reported they had understood this previously.

Although this was Drew's first trip with DM2, he glided into the role like a professional – traveling without complaint, teaching many lessons, singing hymns with the people, and witnessing to a Buddhist. Drew also reached out to many other local pastors we met along the way with invitations to attend our conference this time and again next year. His servant's heart was evident to all!

Each day for five days between 30-35 men and women attended the six hour training sessions, enduring temperatures in the 90's with a humidity of 95% (without air-conditioning). Needless to say, teaching was a challenge and listening an even greater one. We planned for forty attendees (as in our previous workshops) but ran out of workbooks on the first day. Although this was a good problem we did not anticipate, we will plan accordingly next time.

Additionally, after noticing on a previous trip that many attendees did not have them, on this trip we provided Bibles. Normally, the people do not ask many questions about the material. When we asked about the lack of questions, the response was, "It is our way." Happily, on this trip, the people asked more questions than on previous trips. We believed this to be progress. Also, we had not received many comments in the past about the workshops, but this time we counted approximately 15 comment cards. We appreciate your prayers for Matthew, our translator and interpreter. He has recovered from his bout with malaria and has returned to full strength.

Moreover, we are thankful for your financial and prayer support. Your prayers for this trip were not a minor role! They paved the journey with the smoothest ride possible and a safe return. You all played a major part! As Paul challenged in Romans 10:14-17, "How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? How will they preach unless they are sent?"

Timothy: Through this workshop, I was encouraged by the clear and pure Gospel and the doctrine of eternal security. It is a special opportunity to understand the truth that believers are hidden with Christ in God. Let us declare the pure Gospel to those who have not heard it.

Anonymous: Through the workshop I learned the truth of our old nature in Adam and our new nature in Christ. It encourages me much to continue to share the true Gospel. I now understand the dispensation (house law) of Israel and the church better. Thank you.

Martha: I have understood clearly the mysteries of the church in these days. I thank God and the ones who taught us this truth. I'm also glad that I got this opportunity to learn the very Word of God. Thanks a million.

David: This is the third time I have attended a DM2 workshop. It means I have learned the entire book of Romans with you. These are special opportunities. I give thanks to God and those who teach us. The teaching is very clear. I have learned the pure Gospel and I have the desire to teach this truth to other people.
