Yesterday they arrived early to begin making bread (to save on costs of the workshop). Evidently, Jhonny is not accustomed to using a mud-oven, so he burned some of the bread. After the bread, they had to get the sound system set up (you can't do anything without a sound system in Bolivia). It was a bit of a challenge, but after some tinkering, they had it fixed. As you can see in the picture, Jhonny is wearing a headphone in one ear because they are using the headset as a lapel mic. They are recording their sessions for young people to listen to later.
