Greetings!

God is working in exciting ways through DM². We currently have two important discipleship trips planned for the end of this year.

From October 6-17, we will be traveling to Freetown, Sierra Leone to host a pastors' conference. We will be teaching an overview of the Old Testament. This curriculum, developed by Pastor Clay Ward, focuses on the unfolding characteristics of God leading to the finished work of Christ.

This trip is a vital first step in our teaching program in West Africa; please keep it in your prayers. Pray for a powerful impact on the hearts of the pastors there. Pray also for the development of strong disciple-makers from these efforts. Thanks to God's abundant provision, this conference will not cost the pastors anything but the time they invest to attend.

DM² will return to Bolivia from December 2-19, to continue the ministry there. We have been ministering in Bolivia for over four years and the work is progressing incredibly well. Let me share with you some testimonies of what God is doing through His disciple-makers in Bolivia:

"We are teaching 19 students. We estimate finishing Romans 1-8 by November so that we can take these students with us when we go to the conference in December." (Pastor Lizandro)

"We had a great all day Bible study with the pastors of Los Valles on Monday. We taught Major Bible Themes in the morning and Romans 9 to 16 in the afternoon. There were 10 leaders there." (Missionary Lorenzo)

"I have been listening to Romans on CD. It sounds a bit like listening to a HAM radio but I am thoroughly enjoying it. We would like to use this teaching to reach many others. I really feel that your teaching on Romans is essential to the building up of solid workers in the ministry. We hope to have a Romans 1-8 workshop before you come in December, because I have about 10 interested students... I just wanted to say that I have been profoundly blessed by the studies, and have found myself (and my wife) with a newness that comes from walking by the Spirit. Many times I have walked according to the flesh and haven't even realized what it looked like!" (John, Bible Institute Director)

"I am the Spaniard [Francisco] who attended the workshop in Los Negros, and it gives me great joy to be able to contact you using this means [email]. I remember well the teaching you gave and it has been a blessing to me. I am continually reminded that God has a purpose for me, but my impatience does not allow me to see how the Lord is working in my life. I can see clearly as I look back how He has shaped my circumstances to get me to walk in His ways. I am going to begin teaching Romans by teaching my neighbor Brian, a fifteen year old, who is very intelligent and willing to be taught. Also, I am going to start working on a revision of your Romans 1-8 notes to correct some grammatical issues. When I am done I will send the notes as I promised."

Later this same fellow wrote, *"Pastor Ismael has asked me to send you a PowerPoint presentation to get your thoughts on it, and to see if you want to add more to it. He also told me*

to tell you that he is once again teaching a Romans seminar.” (Francisco desires to someday take this teaching back to his home country of Spain)

We are overjoyed to have a part in what God is doing in these countries. By faith we look forward to seeing this same process happen over and over again in many countries. It is our heartfelt desire to see disciple-makers replicated exponentially, so the gospel of Jesus Christ and the clear teaching of God’s word will spread to the farthest corners of this globe!

DM² is now fully up and running. We have an official office, which sure beats working out of the house! We are thankful to God for this provision.

You have an opportunity to play a crucial role in developing disciple-makers from sea to sea. The following are vital areas in which you can participate:

- We need Regional Ministry Directors. These are gifted individuals who can lead leaders and facilitate the establishment of a disciple making program on a foreign field. Regional Ministry Directors can be from the United States or from overseas. If you are interested, or know of someone who could serve in this capacity, please let us know.
- DM² has approximately half of its necessary monthly support. This is critical for maintaining and continuing the scope of DM². You can have a part by considering a monthly, or one time, gift to this ministry.
- We need a huge prayer team. Since God has commanded us to go to all nations to make disciples, we depend on Him to open doors, work in hearts and lives, and provide the strength and wisdom needed to accomplish His will.
