Dear Friends,

It is with great joy that I write you today to share about a door the Lord opened for us just across the border in Mexico.

Recently, a pastor invited me to minister in his church in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, a neighboring city on the Mexican side of the border. Believers from four different churches attended. Although many of them worked long hours during the day, they faithfully gathered each evening with a genuine hunger for God's word.

Over the course of the week, I taught verse by verse through Romans chapters 1-5. For many of the local leaders, the material was both challenging and encouraging. We spent considerable time discussing God's righteousness, man's sinfulness, justification by faith, and the incredible grace of God revealed through Jesus Christ. Some of these truths stretched long-held assumptions and prompted thoughtful discussion, but throughout the meetings there was a sincere desire to submit to the authority of Scripture.

One of the most encouraging moments took place just before one of the evening sessions. One of the local leaders was visibly excited and wanted to share something with me. As I sat down with him to hear what he had to say, he explained that after listening to the teaching the previous evening, he experienced his first full night's sleep in a very long time. The truths we had been studying from Romans brought him a renewed sense of peace and assurance, and he simply wanted us to know how much the teaching meant to him. It was a wonderful reminder that God's word does more than inform the mind; it ministers to the heart.

One of the greatest blessings for me as a teacher is watching people engage deeply with God's word. As I looked across the room each evening, I saw attentive faces and open Bibles as people carefully followed the teaching. Their thoughtful questions and meaningful discussions were evidence that the Lord was at work in many hearts. It was encouraging to see them wrestle with Scripture with a desire to understand it more accurately.

The churches expressed a strong desire for us to return and continue the study. Lord willing, we hope to make another trip soon to continue building on the foundation that was laid.

Another memorable conversation took place one evening in the car as a local couple drove us to the border. They spoke passionately about the tremendous need for biblical training in Reynosa and shared their desire to see a Bible college established that would teach sound, verse-by-verse doctrine. They expressed their belief that many pastors, leaders, and young believers would eagerly

attend such a program if it were available. They even showed us a property that could potentially be renovated into dormitories and classrooms. While only a distant prospect, the conversation revealed a genuine hunger for biblical training and a desire to see the next generation equipped with a solid understanding of God's word.

The area where we ministered is considered unsafe by many so we would greatly appreciate your prayers for wisdom, protection, and open doors as these opportunities develop. Please also pray that the truths taught from Romans would take deep root in the hearts of those who attended, producing spiritual growth, greater confidence in God's grace, and a stronger commitment to sound doctrine.

Thank you for your faithful prayers, encouragement, and partnership in the ministry. Your support makes opportunities like this possible, and we are grateful for the privilege of serving the Lord together.
