God has also provided us with a cook. Sonia runs a restaurant at night. She loves the Lord and people and has been cooking for us for the past month. Sonia plans to continue to cook for the center in 2022 when classes begin.

Thanks to 3DTC in Beaumont, TX and all the hard work going on over there (we figure there must be two teams working around the clock), we have all the curricula, syllabi, invitations, applications, etc. in a neatly organized package ready for us to simply translate and use.

What is left to be done?

Before the start of classes in February 2022, we will need dorm rooms with bunks and desks for the students, desks and chairs for the classroom, and tables for the cafeteria.

We are also still preparing courses, organizing with the teachers, and working with churches to cast vision and recruit students.

We have contacted DM2-trained teachers all over Bolivia who have agreed to come to the center as visiting professors, but we still need approximately five more teachers.

Pray for visionary churches to send students to be trained to carry on the disciple-making model. Pray also that God will multiply our time and bless our efforts as we continue on in the mission to which He has commissioned us.
