Zambia Workshop (Romans 1-8)

They came from far and wide: from four different nations, from the island of Zanzibar, and from all over Zambia. There were over 120 pastors and church leaders representing 31 denominations.

At the beginning of the week, we passed out a questionnaire to help us get a feel for their understanding of the gospel. It became clear they were very uncertain about salvation and eternal security. So we dove into the book of Romans.

Paul, by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, does a great job of proving we are all lost and in need of justification. After a brief introduction, he addresses the immoral sinner (Romans 1:18-32), the moral sinner (Romans 2:1-16), and the religious sinner (Romans 2:17-3:8). And the verdict is: ALL are without excuse. We are condemned before a just and holy God. The whole world is guilty (Romans 3: 9-20).

But there is hope! Romans 3:21-31 says God freely gave His Son to pay the debt of sin that we could not pay. So we are justified before God by believing

in His Son. We cannot buy our salvation with our works, or maintain our salvation through our works. It is an act of grace on the part of God.

It seemed the large majority understood and accepted the truth of the Word of God. Please pray for these men:

- That, as they review the teaching, they will be convinced of the truths of Romans.
- That the truths taught will be passed on to faithful men and women who will teach others also.
- Pray for Pastor Joseph Chama, the main leader. We would like him to come to a workshop here in the US this November.
- Pray that God will raise up a core group of faithful men who will promote the truth in Zambia and southern Africa.
- Pray that God will direct us with respect to returning and continuing the teaching.

Thank you for your prayers and support for this trip. I trust God will multiply these truths in the hearts of many!

From David Howard:

Our workshop with the Zambian pastors was both enlightening and interesting. This was our first trip to Zambia, as well as our first time to teach this group of pastors. Most were from Zambia, but some came from Tanzania, Congo and Zanzibar. Being our first workshop, the pastors did not know quite what to expect from us. We, too, were uncertain as to how they would react to Paul's teaching of grace. Our initial survey, which they completed on the first day, revealed the group had a wide range of views on what was required for salvation.

The first couple of days were pretty intense. There were a lot of questions about Paul's teachings in Romans 1-3 concerning how all of humanity is condemned in God's eyes. Those chapters show that salvation is obtained through faith alone in Christ alone, not through good works. Salvation is neither obtained, nor maintained, through good works. As we worked our way through Romans 4 and 5, you could really see "the light bulbs" turn on as most of the pastors came to understand the difference between justification, sanctification and glorification for the first time in their lives. By the time we got through Romans 6 and explained the sin nature as the "root" and actual sins as the "fruit", they were truly engaged and interacting with a lot of enthusiasm. By the end of the week, they had a new perspective gained from Romans. Most left clearly committed to re-teaching what they had learned.

It is truly amazing to see God's Word come alive to such a diverse group of pastors. Most of them had traveled many miles to be there. They were such great students. They paid close attention to our teaching for many hours a day in a hot room with very few breaks. It was inspiring to me to watch a group of leaders work through their own theological prejudice and come to terms with what God's word actually says. I came away convinced that DM2's curriculum and teaching methods really do work.

This is a teaching method that excels especially when there are alternating teachers. As the team rotates through the curriculum, alternatively reading applicable verses and explaining them through the teaching outline, it carefully and methodically garners the focus of the student and produces an interactive experience. It is hard to explain how effective this method is. It's something you really must experience to fully appreciate. So if you haven't yet signed up for a DM2 workshop, please do so! Sure, it's a lot of hard work and an intense few days, but you will come away a different person, prepared to be a "faithful man or woman" of 2 Timothy 2:2, who will be able to teach others also.
