Youth for Jesus/DM2 was established through the efforts of our American brothers, John Clark, Rob Armstrong and others, who sacrifice their lives to reach to Liberia with the GRACE message. The message of grace has transformed our lives and we want to extend the gospel to other parts of the country. Liberia is a post-war country with a bad economic, political, and religious system. The cost of living is high, we have a poor medical system, and the road conditions are bad. We believe that through the entry of the gospel, our nation will be transformed.

The Youth for Jesus was established in 2010, but it did not officially begin to function till DM2 entered Liberia. We presently have 30 trained young people who are eager to spread the gospel. Since DM2 came, we have had workshops in many parts of Liberia. Presently we trust God to reach fifteen counties.

Below are the **testimonies** of people who have been transformed by our DM2 workshops.

"My name is Lawrence T. Jabater. I live in Careysburg City, Montserrado County. I came from a religious sect, and for a very long time I had been in darkness. Since I came in contact with the DM2 team and received the gospel, my life has changed. I am now saved."

"My name is John Kollie. I live in Todee, Montserrado County. I had been in church for over 18 years not knowing Jesus. But since I received the gospel through the Youth for Jesus/ DM2 team, my life has changed."





In October, Youth for Jesus/DM2 held a three-day workshop in Freeman Reserved community. We brought 20 team members. The workshop was so great. Over hundred attended the workshop each day. There were many people who put their faith in the finished work of Jesus. We have more trips planned to Maryland County, Rivercess County, Grand Bassa County, Nimba County, and more.
