This year marked our 8th annual Women in the Word conference. In a world that is becoming increasingly troubled and dark, it truly felt like a glimpse of heaven. As we studied, shared, prayed, sang, ate, and relaxed together, we were reminded of the importance of the one-another passages in Scripture. In Daniel 7, we learned about the vision of the Four Beasts and how they









In Daniel 8, we learned about the vision of the Ram and the Goat butting against one another, and how the Ram, the Medo-Persian Empire, would be overthrown by the Goat, Alexander the Great's Greek Empire. In Daniel 9, we saw God's answer to Daniel's petition. God told him the prophetic timeline of Israel's future judgement and restoration. This prophesy gave the precise time Messiah

would be cut off (die on the cross), as well as when the clock would restart for the final (70th) week of Israel's judgement at the signing of a peace treaty between Israel and the antichrist. In the final vision of Daniel 10-12, we looked at the complicated prophecy concerning the kings of the north and the kings of the south. God used this prophecy to introduce the coming antichrist, with Antiochus Epiphanies being his evil prototype. The entire study of Daniel showed God's sovereignty over human history.

Just like Daniel, we need not fear. We are God's children and loved by Him. He is in control of our lives. We need only to be faithful to Him, recognizing we have everything we need for the abundant life in Christ in this foreign land where we currently reside.
