Our New Testament Panorama workshop in October was my third time visiting Liberia to help deliver a DM2 workshop. the commitment of those who have been continuing to share the DM2 material in their churches and in their own workshops, both near their homes and far away. We have been going to Careysburg, Liberia since 2014, with a brief hiatus during the Ebola outbreak. Although our primary focus is the workshops, other opportunities also arise. During this past trip, while eating breakfast at the hotel, one of the workers, along with four of his assistants, stopped by our table. As we began to talk, the Lord opened a door for us to share the gospel. The leader of the group, Kennedy, and one of the young men, Thomas, seemed especially interested and began asking a wide range of questions such as: Can someone lose their salvation? What if a pastor is having an affair; should he still be a pastor? If I do not give money to the church, will I go to hell?

Each question gave Rob, Alan, Josh, and me opportunities to re-emphasize the FINISHED WORK of Jesus Christ. Our visit went so well they appeared at breakfast for the next few days, asking additional questions. We were able to leave them an MP3 player with DM2's teaching on Romans 1-8 and the book of Galatians. Zambia

In Zambia in October the DM2 team taught Bible study methods to a group of about 150 church leaders. We taught the importance of context, that the best interpreter of the Bible is the Bible itself and the importance of being keen observers. We taught that God intended the Bible to be known, therefore a literal approach to Bible study is the best way to come to right conclusions. The Bible was written to be plainly understood; it was not written with hidden mystical messages of individual interpretation.

Thank you for praying for DM2 workshops. Sometimes it's expensive to travel and hard to be away from home. We spend about 6 to 8 hours per day teaching. The travel is tiring and so is the teaching! I thank the Lord that we team-teach.

Please pray for the country of Bolivia. There is much unrest and violence due to alleged vote tampering during presidential elections. The outcome of these elections may greatly restrict the freedoms in the country. **Larry DePue** (Larry is a missionary in Bolivia and friend of DM2. Despite the "very ugly" situation in Bolivia, he flew to Zambia to help with the workshop and then rejoined his wife in Bolivia.)
