PASTOR JOHN CLARK:

Texas

The *Panorama of the Old Testament* curriculum is well-written and organized; as a pastor I am excited to see how the material has been easily assimilated into our weekly adult Sunday school class. It is great to see two of the gentlemen who attended the workshop in Tennessee now co-teaching the material with me – multiplication at its finest! It has been personally helpful for them, not only to have gone through the course, but now to re-study the material in order to teach it. We are currently using the *Panorama of the Old Testament* curriculum in our Sunday school with good results. Our church sent one individual to the DM2 workshop in Tullahoma, TN in April of 2012. I am going through children's curriculum that DM2 presented in Los Negros and am determined to start teaching biblical foundations to the children of the church using the lessons you provided.
