From Sierra Leone:

On October 6<sup>th</sup> Pastor Clay Ward and I will board a Continental Airline flight that will take us across the ocean to London, England. We will fly through the night. From there we board a jet to Freetown, Sierra Leone where we will be for one week.

Sierra Leone is a small country on the west coast of Africa. Michael Turay serves as the field director for our ministry there. As a native of Freetown, Michael weaves through the culture with great confidence. Interestingly, there are no less than 24 different languages spoken in Sierra Leone. The lingua franca is Krio, but thankfully the official language is English.

During our week in Sierra Leone, we plan to teach a 140 page curriculum authored by Pastor Ward. This course will take the pastors and leaders from Creation (Genesis 1:1) through the entire Old Testament.

Our purpose in hosting this seminar is not only to teach the 30-50 leaders who will be attending, but to empower and inspire these leaders to begin the process of disciple-making themselves; first in their communities, and then teaming together to reach their entire country. It is our conviction that even the humblest Sierra Leoneans can effectively make disciples who in turn reproduce disciples ad infinitum.

**Pray** for open hearts and comprehension for those attending the seminar.

**Pray** for the pastors and leaders to catch a vision for being disciple-makers. The mistaken idea of many Third World believers is that the Great Commission is the sole responsibility of American, or foreign, missions. To counteract this mentality is a great challenge.

**Pray** for Pastor Ward's and my health and safety. At this time of year, dust from the Sahara Desert falls across West Africa, causing many health issues. There is also always the threat of malaria and other diseases.

**Pray** that good electricity would be available throughout the conference, and that our electronic equipment would function properly.
