**Carlos Tellez:** It was a great blessing to take part in teaching the conference on 1, 2, and 3 John alongside Bret and other local teachers at Monte Blanco Camp in Bolivia. What deeply impacted me was seeing so many couples truly hungry for the truth revealed in these epistles.
