Teaching through the book of Jude at Riverdrive Park Bible Chapel was a true blessing for me, and hopefully also for all who attended. So why is this 1-page book I flip through to get to Hebrews important? While it's true false teachers have existed in the church from the start, today their numbers and influence have grown exponentially. According to Pew Research Center, only 40% of professing U.S. Christians are Protestant, and of those, only 46% believe in salvation by faith alone in Christ alone. This means only about 18% of professing Christians understand and embrace a clear gospel, and these numbers continue to dwindle.

Jude strongly rebukes false teachers who deceive believers and lead entire congregations astray. Their primary target has always been the gospel of true grace. Jude provides crucial guidance for identifying and dealing with these threats. If the church fails to protect the purity of the gospel, we lose our primary purpose as the "pillar and support of the truth (1 Tim. 3:15)."

I'm deeply thankful we had the chance to teach through this concise, but powerful book. I pray we'll apply Jude's message faithfully, becoming "doers of the word, not merely hearers (Jam. 1:22)."
