This month our team departs for a preliminary survey trip to North Africa. God has worked many miracles to make this trip possible and we see it as a wonderful opportunity to reach the Middle East with the Word of God. Pray for safety, guidance, and open doors.

In Bolivia this month the pastors and leaders are hosting several conferences on the books of Romans and Galatians (refer to page 2 for more information).

The leaders DM² has trained in Sierra Leone are also continuing to spread the true message of the Word of God. Here is a letter from Field Director Michael Turay:

Let me give you a summary report on what has been going on since the October DM² training here in Sierra Leone.

Out of the people that went through the DM² training, 14 in the capital city of Freetown are actively training 99 disciples. In Makeni, 25 of the trainees are actively training 204 disciples. The others have decided to personally go through the study again before trying to teach it. I am really excited to see how many will endure and go through the entire training program.

Personally, I am teaching the DM² teaching materials to my wife, two of my kids, and seven other members of my church who have never gone through any theological training. We are all learning so much from it.

One of the DM² students, a pastor from Makeni, confessed to us that before going through the DM² training, he was so out of touch with studying God's Word he had nothing to say to his congregation.

Sadly, He was getting his sermons from the Watch Tower Magazine. Now, he has more than enough material for teaching his people using the manual that was given to him.

We are very grateful for what God is doing through the DM^2 training.



Three more conferences will be held by DM² trainees.

Two Simba-Guarani men whom we have trained, Felix and Arturo, will be teaching tribal churches in their native language. At the same location Pastors Ismael, Angel, Javier, and Gil will teach a conference to Spanish-speaking pastors. And several hundred miles away in the state of Cochabamba, other DM2 trainees will be teaching the book of Galatians.



Discipleship is passing on what you learn from the Word of God to other faithful believers who will continue the process, spreading the Word of God far and wide across the earth.

I witnessed this process being set into motion about seven years ago. While I was pastoring at Harlingen Bible Church, God put it on the church's heart to become more effective in evangelism. I contacted Pastor Dennis Rokser of Duluth Bible Church and asked if he would send a group to teach our church how to do "fairground evangelism." Consequently, Pastor Kurt Witzig brought a college-age team from DBC to train us.

After a few training sessions, we spent a Saturday sharing the Gospel at an open market in our town. We shared the Gospel with nearly 100 people. Since then, once every month the church has set up tents and shared the Gospel at that open market. Through these efforts, many people have come to know the Lord. Amazingly, God gave Harlingen Bible Church the opportunity to teach several other churches how to effectively minister using this approach.

One day, at a conference in Dallas, I

met Dr. Michael Halsey. He had heard about the way we did evangelism and asked me about it. During a ten minute break between sessions I explained to him how to use the fairground evangelism method. Pastor Halsey contacted me a few more times via email about the evangelism method and then taught his congregation at County Line Church in Hampton, Georgia. Since then, they have been extremely successful in evangelism.

Here is an article from a member of Pastor Halsey's congregation:

I was intrigued when Dr. Mike introduced his plan to start an evangelism team at County Line Church. I went to the training sessions and was so excited about this non-threatening/non-confrontational

approach of sharing the Gospel using a Spiritual Viewpoint Questionnaire as a tool to invite people to hear the Gospel. This was the answer to the nagging frustration of always feeling like I'm not doing my part...

It has been exciting to work with the County Line Team at both on and off campus events. The people who sit with me to answer the questionnaire are receptive to sharing their views and most willing to listen to me share the Good News. It's a beautiful thing when people share their acceptance and understanding of the Gospel or expresses their joy after gaining clarity in areas in which they were confused....

Having learned about our outreach through one of our team members, Katherine Van Lengen, a Baptist church in Zebulon, GA, invited our team to visit them...

Dr. Mike and Katherine gave a great presentation...on sharing the Gospel using this method.

What I didn't anticipate was the large number of people from that small church who showed up for this gathering and the enthusiasm and electricity that was in the air from the excitement of the eager attendants. Ninety percent of the people in the auditorium appeared to be over 50 years old...

At the conclusion of the presentation, a lady said, "This is perfect; it's the best method of evangelism I've ever heard." Another person was so excited to get involved in this evangelism she said, "You can't come back soon enough to start training us!" And still

another couple started naming possible functions in their community they could attend in order to share the Gospel using this newly discovered method.

This meeting in Zebulon has gotten me excited all over again! The best part about of all of this is not working with the team, going to the community functions, or losing that nagging feeling that I'm not doing my part. These are all wonderful, but the colossal part about all of this is being obedient to the Lord and doing what God, in His Word, has asked us to do in Matt. 28:19 "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations...." In doing so we accomplish His will as stated in 2 Cor. 4:15 "... so that the grace that is reaching more and more people may cause thanksgiving to overflow to the alory of God."

I can't wait until the next event when we can set up our interview tables and start giving the Gospel. We're Christ's ambassadors. Let's go out into the world and share His Truth!

What a picture of discipleship in action: one church passed on its method of evangelism to another, who in turn passed it on to another, and so on resulting in the Gospel being spread to thousands of people.

Hello Bret,

You can give us a call when you arrive in Cairo and we can arrange a meeting.
