David Howard Half Time in Zambia



It is hard to believe we have been teaching in Zambia for five years now. It has been a real encouragement to see God provide for each trip, often at the last minute. Committing to a ten-year program requires a lot of prayer and faith. Resting in God's faithfulness, with a complete dependence on God to provide for each trip, gets us through the uncertainties that are ever-present with each passing year.

Because DM2 commits to a region for ten years, there must be a mutual commitment to weather the ups and downs along the way. Pastor Joseph Chama, DM2's field director in Zambia, has provided the consistent leadership necessary to bring together pastors for the DM2 workshops every October and April. On our last trip he took us out to see a new church they were building and also a new training center where he plans to teach the DM2 curriculum to pastors from all over the country.

When we first arrived, Pastor Chama was in charge of 40 churches. Now he is responsible for 66 churches. At DM2, we realize these local pastors can do a better job of teaching their own congregations than we can. Our purpose is to give them the training and tools they need so they can accurately teach the Word to their own brothers and sisters and equip them to serve the Lord.

So far, we have taught Romans 1-8, Romans 9-16, Galatians, Colossians, Old Testament Panorama (2 sections), Life of Christ Panorama (2 sections), and the New Testament Panorama (2 sections). That is 10

blocks of teaching in 40-50 hour increments, resulting in over 400 hours of teaching and training! Each of these blocks of teaching are retaught throughout the 66 churches under Pastor Chama's leadership, as well as in hundreds of other churches in remote villages and neighboring countries.

DM2 is now translating each new curriculum into Bemba, the local language. We use two screens when we teach, one with English power points and one with Bemba. We teach in English and use a Bemba translator. Having the curriculum and the power points in Bemba is making a huge difference in communicating effectively. As we slowly but steadily teach through each curriculum, a trove of teaching material is being created. Nothing like this exists in Bemba for these national pastors and the results of faithfully teaching over time is paying off. Using the DM2 methodology and replicable approach, God's Word will be accurately retaught for many years.

After five years, the momentum is building in Zambia. There is a lot of excitement around each new curriculum, since the pastors eagerly and diligently use what is taught to teach their own congregations. As pastors get trained, there is growth in the churches throughout the country and more leaders are raised up.

We are looking forward to the next five years, all the while knowing we are completely dependent on God's provision to keep moving forward. Looking back, it is encouraging to see God's faithfulness. We anticipate with confident assurance that God has included in His plans and purposes a bright future for our Zambian brothers and sisters. It is with great joy that we have the privilege of serving alongside them through DM2.

Since the inception of the DM2 program, I have benefited in the lessons DM2 is teaching us here in Zambia in the community of Kasama. My understanding of biblical truth has risen to another level. I am now able to teach effectively in the churches which are under my leadership. I have taught my church the book of Romans, the discipleship curriculum, and a number of the books of the Bible. This has helped me because some of the members, not all of them, are now involved in disciple-making.



DM2 has also helped me in terms of evangelism. I have planted a church in Lua Luo and I have opened a preaching point in Lwimbo village beyond the Kasama airport, with the intention of opening it as a branch church. We know that the continuation of this teaching will broaden our knowledge and understanding of biblical things.

It is my prayer that God will continue using DM2 and providing you with funds so that you won't give up this good work (Galatians 6:9). The Lord who began this work in you will continue helping you (Philippians 1:6).

I was privileged to be a part of the DM2 team that traveled to Zambia in October. Together with David Howard and Bret Nazworth, we conducted a five-day workshop covering the book of Acts, including many of the New Testament letters. Approximately 125 pastors, elders and others participated in the training. It was very encouraging to see their enthusiasm for the gospel of grace and their desire for clear teaching of God's Word. The attendees listened intently for several hours each day as we taught the Scriptures with the help of our Bemba language translators. As we progressed through the PowerPoint slides, they followed along closely in their workbooks, either in Bemba or in English. It is my understanding that after the workshops most of the pastors use their workbooks to teach in their churches. This means we are having a real part in making disciples who make disciples! What I like about the DM2 workbooks is that they not only help equip these pastors personally, but they also provide a practical, easy-to-use, Bible commentary that can be referred to for years to come.

I believe we are witnessing something very special in Kasama, the community where we teach. In fact, I would

describe what I saw as a grace awakening. Pastors from many different denominations and theological backgrounds are coming together in unity to study the Word of God (book-by book and verse-byverse). For many, these workshops are their first exposure to Bible exposition, and even to the gospel itself. I believe that a large number of these men and women have come to understand and believe the gospel for the very first time during the five years that the workshops have been going on. Many others are gaining a richer and deeper understanding of the significance of Christ's death and resurrection, justification by faith, and our heavenly position in Christ. It was absolutely wonderful to see the response on their faces when we spoke of God's grace. I am honored and thankful to the Lord to have participated in this ministry.

Over the last 20 years, the pastors and people in Zambia have been exploited by false teachers, both spiritually and financially. Tragically, many of these teachers come from the Unites States. Works-based and obedience-based gospels run rampant in Zambia and most other places in Africa. I praise the Lord for DM2 because of our model of verse-byverse teaching and our strong emphasis on salvation by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone!

DM2 has also directly helped our church be strong in faith and equipped us with tools to use in our churches scattered across the nation. Our local church now fully understands what disciple-making is and how to multiply disciples with proper sound doctrine. We are now able to differentiate between what is truth and myth or falsehood.

DM2's training has helped in my training ministries as I teach able men who will in turn be able to train

others. Our ministry is now busy planting churches in remote places where Christ has not been known. The DM2 materials are the very tools we are using to establish and ground believers in the Lord. In short, DM2 is training our leaders each time they come for a workshop. We draw all our leaders to these workshops, which has proven to be very helpful.

DM2 has assisted us in translating these materials into our local language, which is really helping the rural churches understand the teachings fully. DM2 assists the pastors with Bibles to make them fully equipped. Some of our pastors were unable to buy Bibles so they were using pamphlets, gospel tracts, or any literature they could get hold of to teach the members in their churches. Thank God DM2 donated Bibles to these pastors.

DM2 is really a gift from God to our pastors. It is a great opportunity for most of us who cannot afford to go to Bible college or pay a seminary fee. DM2 has sacrificed a lot to build a strong foundation for our people in our churches. God bless you David, Bret and ALL DM2 supporters.
