"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations ... and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20

In giving the Great Commission, the Lord instituted a major departure from the plan He had for Israel. Israel was supposed to be a light to the Gentiles (Isaiah 42:6), a city on a hill, and the nations would be drawn to God through her light (Matthew 5:14). During the Millennium, the Gentile nations will again gather to the Lord in this manner, but for now, according to the Great Commission, the Lord commands us to GO to the nations with this amazing message of the Gospel (Acts 1:8). This radical shift in God's methodology for reaching the world was new for church-age believers, and it seems that it took persecution to finally encourage the early church to get moving (Acts 8:1-4).

The Great Commission is God's command to believers to go make disciples from among all nations. We are not to sit still and wait for the world to come to us as was the case with Israel.

Not only did God give church-age believers a distinct responsibility, He also gave us a new message to pass on. We are not to proclaim the coming King or His kingdom; we are to proclaim the Good News that Christ died for our sins and rose again on the third day (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)! This is the precise message Peter preached from the day

Last September, our church hosted a Disciple Makers Multiplied workshop on the Panorama of the Old Testament. Immediately, I saw the excellence of both the content and the way the information is delivered. I have never seen anything like it, and the many people of my church who attended responded with genuine enthusiasm. Since then, we hosted a conference in April on Romans 1-8 for women only led by two ladies (my wife included). It was also received with much joy. We are now eager to host a DM2 conference on the Life of Christ this coming fall.

As I have experienced, DM2 workshops are a great benefit to churches:

- They promote sound Bible teaching on both salvation and the spiritual life of believers.
- They provide an amazing overview and knowledge of the Bible, equipping believers in their daily walk with God.
- They train teachers to become disciple-makers and multiply themselves in evangelism and spiritual growth, fulfilling the Great Commission of Christ.
- They create a sense of urgency and joy in local churches toward making new disciples.
- They vitalize churches that have become stale or complacent.

As a church, we prayerfully seek to develop a disciple-making hub in Latin America where many pastors may be trained to transform their churches into Holy Spirit-powered disciplemaking centers. We hope to have a team of several men who are skilled teachers of sound Bible doctrine who can go forth and teach in these efforts. Would you team together with us in prayer as we move in this direction and become that vital hub, faithful to God's Word and the Great Commission, usable to the Glory of God? And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." (Mark 16:15)

April 10th through 14th gave me the joyful honor of participating in a Disciple Makers Multiplied (DM2) workshop on the Panorama of the Life of Christ. Pleroma Bible Church in Tullahoma, TN hosted the event for pastors and believers from various parts of the country. The objective of DM2 is to train disciples who will in turn take the Word of God as presented in the DM2 curriculum and teach it to other faithful men and women who will go out and continue the process of making disciples who are dependent upon the Scriptures rather than any specific teacher.

The workshop was taught by seven men who rotated through the sections during the event. I had the great honor of teaching five of those sections. The course is set up to be divided into one hour lessons and we provided a 5-15 minute break between each lesson as well as lunch and dinner on site. The course addresses the life of Christ by harmonizing all four Gospels in chronological order. The teaching started with two one-hour lessons on Wednesday night at 6pm. Thursday, the first session began at 8am and the sessions continued with the last one concluding around 10:30pm. Friday also began at 8am with the last session of the day ending at 9:30pm. Saturday we started at 6:30am and the last session of the day ended at 10:30pm. The final two sessions were Sunday morning from 9:30 to 11:45. In total we had 36 hours of teaching with short breaks every hour.

As you can see, the conference was a very intense teaching and learning effort but as one pastor puts it, salvation is free but discipleship is costly. There was significant benefit for me in the fact that we had a detailed study of the life if Christ completed in just a few days. The connections between the

different Gospels and the chronology became much clearer when it was all covered from start to finish in a short time frame. One student expressed that he had known the Lord only in black and white and this study added full color to his understanding of the life of Christ. Another said he would not like for his obituary to read that he had missed a DM2 workshop! It is honestly a lot of information to try to soak up in a short time frame, but by the end of the course the students were able to walk away with a workbook full of notes, the entire PowerPoint presentations of the course, and several reference materials. Later, they can also access video and audio recordings of the conference for reference. While everything is not absorbed and committed to memory the first time through, as you go back and study the curriculum and then teach it to someone else, you will begin to understand more and more of it. This workshop laid the foundation to build upon allowing each attendee to teach the truth to other faithful men and women. The conference and all of the materials received were free of charge for all who came. DM2 has only one expectation: That the students take what they have learned and teach it to someone else.

On Friday, May 10th, at around 2:30pm, I will fly out of Nashville and arrive in Sierra Leone at approximately 6:30pm on Saturday. There, Bret Nazworth, Larry Depue, and I will be teaching the curriculum on making disciple-makers and the Romans 9-16 curriculum to faithful men and women from the surrounding area. The schedule will be much like the one described above with plenty of material covered throughout the week. We will be teaching almost non-stop in order to complete both sets of material in time to catch our flight back to the US the following Saturday. Please be in prayer for safe travels and the health of the teachers as we spend hours communicating God's truth to eager students. Pray for our families during our absence. DM2 depends on the grace giving of faithful believers in order to offer their workshops and materials free of charge to those who are eager to learn and teach God's Word, so please pray for continued support. Continue to pray for the work in other countries, that the Gospel message will be received and preached.

Ukraine

FROM PASTOR MARK MUSSER:

Pastor Mark Musser recently taught the DM2 Romans 9-16 curriculum in Kiev, Ukraine at a Bible College founded by Jim Myers. DM2 would love to see Pastor Musser return and teach the Romans 1-8 curriculum in September with the expectation that individuals begin to make disciple-makers throughout that part of the world. Here is his report:

I thought the teaching of the DM2 materials on Romans 9-16 went well in Kiev, Ukraine. The trainees were in charge of the teaching the second week, and did just fine. In some cases, they did really well. I believe a light bulb turned on for a few of them, and there might be some future DM2 opportunities when they return to their respective home towns. One young man is from Krasnoyarsk, in the middle of Siberia. He is definitely interested in bringing Romans 1-8 to Siberia. Also, American student Bob Bolender, after teaching a section over Romans 13:1-7 in class, took that section and retaught it at a Bible study – so it came in guite handy for him. This was no easy task as he taught it all in Russian and did really well. As is to be expected, not everyone did perfectly. One individual taught the material somewhat backwards and managed to confuse everyone a bit – but thankfully the notes brought him back to where he needed to be. This shows the positive aspect of the outlines being taught this way!

The picture below is of Maxim. I unloaded Romans 15:13 on him (a large section) and he did an excellent job teaching it. He later thanked me for the opportunity to teach the

materials and has interest in bringing DM2 to Lugansk in the future. He would need to organize folks together to bring this to fruition. These are things to certainly pray about for the future.
